FAQ SHEET

Question #1

Where is Katy, Texas, and why there to plant an Hispanic church?

ANSWER TO #1

Katy is a suburb on the west side of Houston. The Katy area has a population of a half million people. The actual town of Katy, which is nearby the Good News Baptist Church, is 25% Hispanic.

Question #2

Where do you plan to attend language school?

ANSWER TO #2

Baptist Mid-Missions recommends one of two locations for the study of Spanish. Primarily they have sent missionaries to Rio Grande Bible Institute in Edinburg, Texas. There is also the possibility of studying in Costa Rica.

Question #3

How do you intend to penetrate the barriers you will encounter in reaching this people group?

ANSWER TO #3

In the midst of establishing relationships with the Hispanic people by friendliness and hospitality we will endeavor to show them Christ. Next we would offer a Bible study, and allow them to see for themselves the truth of God.
