Update on Molly

Molly was in the hospital for almost three weeks. She got discharged last friday from Mercy Hospital. She spent almost a week in ICU. In the beginning doctors couldn't find out what was causing her high fever and chills. They started her with a broad spectrum of antibiotics, which didn't help her much. But the prayers of many saints were answered by our God who is Jehovah -Rapha, gave healing to Molly. Doctors were amazed to see her improvement, when they thought they can't do much about her high fevers and chills. When they were planning to do open lung biopsy, God intervened and Molly started improving. We praised God that Molly didn't have to go through the lung biopsy procedure. Molly's blood culture and x-rays and C.T. Scans didn't help much to diagnose her illness. It was after three weeks, one of her blood cultures grew fungus. What she had was a fungal infection. She is now under anti-fungal treatment. She would be treated for six months. We would appreciate your prayers on her behalf. She is responding well to her new medicine. We are praising for God that!

She is still weak and needs help to walk around. She is recovering and getting her strength back day by day. We are prasing God for her.

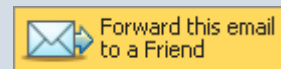

Update on my Parents

It was about the time we were rejoicing about Molly's recovery, we received a phone call from India. We were told that my parents (Henry's parent} had a serious accident. Both of them were taken to a Hospital. Both of them got seriously injured. Both of them have back injuries and fractures on their legs. My mom had three ribs broken and her hip was dislocated. Both of them could stay in the Hospital for three days only because they didn't have any kind health insurance. They need lots of prayers. Both of them are now bed-ridden. They would have to take bed rest for 8 weeks or more. But in order to get recovery from these injuries, they need some kind of equipment at home like special mattresses, braces and bed etc. I would like to go visit them and try to help them. We need at least \$5000 to cover the expense of their treatment. Please pray for our need.

2. Please pray for my parents situation. They need treatment for their injuries. God would meet their financial need.
